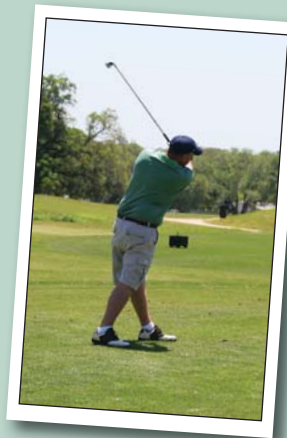

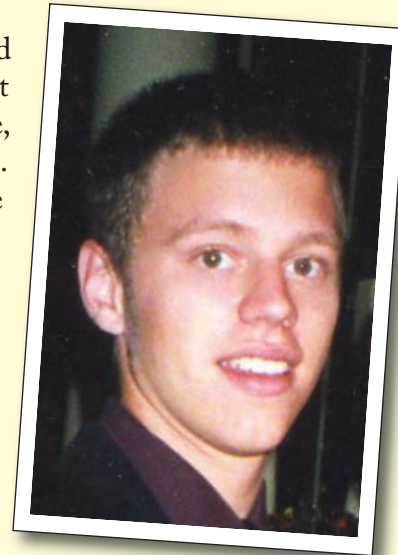

Dale Pullen was born in Tallahassee, Florida on January 7, 1983. His talent and interest in music was obvious as a toddler singing Bruce Springsteen's "Born In The USA." He sang his first solo in a church musical "Down by the Creek Bank" as a five-year-old.

In middle school, Dale received Superior Ratings in district competition for Solo and Ensemble, as well as special recognition awards. He began guitar lessons and by the time he entered high school was quite accomplished and performed regularly for family and friends. High school musical experiences included advanced choral groups, individual competitions, talent shows, voice lessons, and participation in musical productions.



However, in the early morning hours of February 20, 2000, Dale was involved in a single-vehicle accident. Regrettably, Dale was not wearing a seat belt and lost his life.

Three days later at the funeral service, a classmate wrote "Buckle Up In Memory of Dale Pullen" in shoe polish on the back window of their car. After seeing this, Dale's younger sister, Amber, suggested that bumper stickers be printed and distributed at local high schools as a way of remembering Dale and reminding others to buckle up. Thus the "Buckle Up For Dale" seat belt safety campaign began.

Along with the "Buckle Up For Dale" campaign, the Pullen family also organized a scholarship fund in loving memory of Dale. The Dale Pullen Scholarship Fund was established at the urging of family friends wanting to create a lasting tribute that would allow Dale's love of music to continue through the lives of other talented students.

Each year, the faculty of the Leon High School Choral Department selects the recipient of the Dale Pullen Memorial "Star" Award. The "Star" Award is presented to the senior choral student who shares Dale's passion for music, has been judged an outstanding talent and has demonstrated a willingness to serve others. The financial contributions from prior tournaments have provided sufficient funds to endow a scholarship fund to provide financial assistance to all future "Star" Award recipients. This scholarship is administered through the nonprofit Community Foundation of North Florida.

The generous contributions to this year's tournament will provide additional scholarship funds for other high school choral students through the nonprofit Leon Friends of Music, Inc. Proceeds from the tournament will be used to sponsor and provide financial aid to the choral program for needs such as uniform rentals, voice lessons, music camps, clinics and competitions.
